### Rule Changes:

#### A) Slalom

- (1) The second run in slalom will consist of four passes (12', 18', 24', and 30' off for men).
- (2) The Slalom events will be run on consecutive buoys only - additional will not be counted initially. If there is a tie, additional will be counted during the runoff and used if necessary to break the tie.
- (3) There will be another loop added at 33 feet off.

#### B) Tricks

- (1) There will be no time limit (was 1 second) on the basic side slide. Only stipulation is a full 90 degrees.
- (2) There have been some new tricks added e.g. ramp stepover.

#### C) Jumping

- (1) There will be a new scoring breakdown. A maximum 2 points on approach, 4 points in the air, and 4 points on landing. (It was 1-4-5.)

There will not be a new rule book this year. An addendum may be obtained by writing AWSA headquarters.

AWSA Club affiliation dues are as follows:
